Huddle in Broby - an open home to all youth

Huddle in Broby is a project run by a group of young adults. We live together in a christian community in the church of Sweden. The thing we all have in common is our great urge to care for young people and their situation.

The vision of Huddle in Broby is four-fold:

- 1. We want to create an international community of youths, where young people share life as christians, learn to live in love and care for one another and to see our differences as an asset. The community will be a meeting place for young people in Broby, Osby, Knislinge and Glimåkra, four neighboring villages in the south part of Sweden.
- 2. We want to build relationships with young people in our area through voluntary work in youth groups and confirmation classes in the church of Sweden, and on schools campuses to support the students.
- 3. In the community we are training leadership with taking part in building the community together, solving conflicts and work on our relations, with inspiration from different concepts, among others Lifeshapes, 24-7, SALT (short for Scandinavian Academy of Leadership and Theology) and Glimåkra Bible College.
