- Cancel debts of poor and low-income countries to enable them to strengthen their healthcare and other social services. Cancelling these debts will definitely save lives.
- Source additional financing to support all countries in distress due to the economic, social and health impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, including facilitating access to the IMF Special Drawing Rights (SDRs).
- Issuing debt payment moratoriums and create expedient debt reprofiling processes for countries impacted by the coronavirus.
- Advice countries on best ways to emerge from the crisis with more resilience, and to increase protection for the vulnerable, strengthen institutions and instill greater public budget transparency and how to promote responsible lending and borrowing.
