



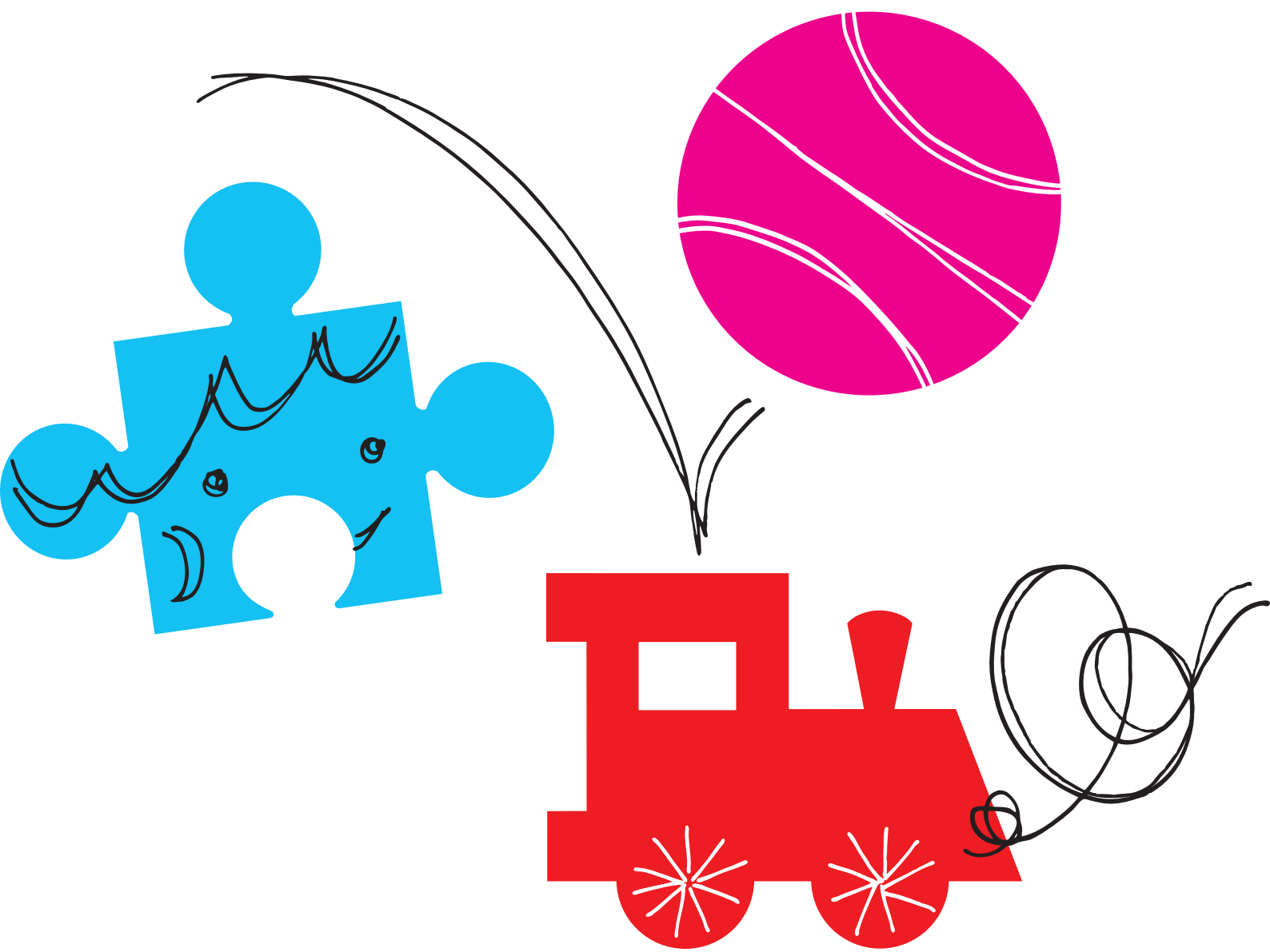
Open preschool

The open preschool is a meeting place where you and your child/children can meet other children and adults.

No registration is required and it is free of charge.

You and your child do not have to be members of the Church of Sweden, or Christians, to participate in the activities of the Church of Sweden.

Preschool is for children between 0–6 years of age and lasts a couple of hours with singing time, games, coffee and socializing.
