Isabel Allende, Latin America's most well known and successful woman author, is to visit the Göteborg Book Fair this year from 24th-27th September. She will answer questions about her work at St Andrew's Church, Hvitfeltsplatsen 2, on Friday 25th September at 19.00.

Her debut novel - *The House of the Spirits in 1982* - brought Isabel Allende immediate success, and since then she has written over 15 novels, as well as books for children and young adults. Her books have sold more than 50 million copies worldwide and been translated into over 30 languages. Allende was born in 1942 and forced to flee her homeland of Chile after the military coup in 1973. She now lives in California. Her latest book *The Sum of Our Days* has been translated into Swedish.. The book is in the form of a letter to her deceased daughter Paula. She describes daily and dramatic happenings in her large Latin American family in an unsentimental, candid and humorous fashion.
